Fletcher Drive Bridge Over Los Angeles River
Construction Activities through April 2011

What work will be done?	Before beginning any significant construction work , the Contractor will be clearing vegetation in the construction zone to prevent any birds from nesting, install a water diversion system, build a temporary access ramp into the river, and other mobilization activities. Also, the City has hired a qualified biologist to implement a nest monitoring program for bats and swallows.
Where is the work occurring?	Under the Fletcher Drive Bridge.
When will work begin and end?	The nest monitoring program will begin by mid-February and be on-going through the end of the rainy season (i.e. October 15 th). The Contractor's clearing work is scheduled to begin prior to March 1, 2011 and will take approximately 2 days. The water diversion work is scheduled to begin in early April 2011 will take approximately 2 days. Additional mobilization activities through the end of April.
What time will crews be working?	Work will be done during the day. No night work is planned at this time.
What can I expect?	No impact to the community.
Will local access be impacted?	The bike path will remain open to the public
Safety Measures	Construction crew will be following appropriate safety standards.
